To contribute to the globalization of Kumamoto, the Elementary School Attached to the Faculty of Education, Kumamoto University, is planning to establish a new International Program to be opened in April, 2026. Prior to the start of the program, we have International Quota for pupils residing in Kumamoto (Foreign citizens). They will take part in the general class with English support from October, 2024.

As an affiliated school of a national university, our school has the missions of both conducting pre-service teacher training for students of the Faculty of Education, Kumamoto University and implementing educational research and practice by collaborating with the other affiliated schools: kindergarten, junior high school, school for special needs education, and other research institutions. Therefore, unique activities based on our own education plans will also be conducted.

1. Admission of International Quota (First Grade)

Children will be accepted as first grade pupils qualified as either applicant Type A or B.

* Type A: Transferring from another school in Japan (Tennyu)

Type B: Transferring from another school or educational institute outside Japan (Hennyu)

3. Qualification

Applicants must follow all of the requirements from (1) to (3).

- (1) Foreign nationals who are able to communicate in English. Applicants and their parent(s)/guardian(s) are expected to be interested in Japanese education in English.
- (2) Children who were born between April 2, 2017 and April 1, 2018.

(3) Reside within the Kumamoto region and be able to commute to and from school within 50 minutes in principle.

Additionally, if the applicant's Residence Card is being issued or renewed, please inform the admission staff during the submission of the application documents and submit the copy of the renewed one to the staff on the exam day (the original document should also be presented).
- ⑤ Application fee: 3,300 Japanese yen (not refundable, cash only)

Please submit the application documents by hand to the office of the Elementary School Attached to the Faculty of Education, Kumamoto University, before the deadline.

Reception slip (uketsukehyo) and receipt will be issued after the submission.

6. Entrance Examination

- (3) Testing policy and method: Considering the characteristics of international program of our school, the applicants' comprehensive ability including listening, thinking, and understanding information in English will be evaluated and then interviewed to test ability to face and answer questions in English during the exam. Along with applicants' testing, the parent(s)/guardian(s) are also interviewed to confirm the intent of child's enrollment at our school (Interviews are either in English or Japanese).
